The opportunity to network with other REALTORS® is a valuable experience in the real estate profession. This program provides you with the confidence and motivation to become more involved in your profession and social communities.

Applications must be returned to the Ocala/Marion County Association of REALTORS® no later than December 31, 2022. Selection of participants for next year's program will be notified no later than the beginning January.

Classes will begin in March and end in August. Times will vary for several of the courses and a class schedule will be included with your acceptance letter.

Applicants agree to pay \$99.00 at time of application.

Only two (2) excused absences allowed (local events) for the entire Leadership Academy schedule or applicant will be dismissed from current program and application fee will be forfeited. Applicant may apply for the next Leadership Academy the following year.

If a session is missed, a make-up activity approved by the Leadership Academy Committee must be completed.

Attendance at the FloridaRealtors® scheduled sessions in Orlando is mandatory. The hotel room (double occupancy) food expense (\$50.00 per day) and registration fee will be paid by Ocala/Marion County Association of REALTORS®. The applicant will be responsible for transportation to all events unless an OMCAR sponsored bus is offered.
